### 1. Campaign Overview:

### 2. Minimum Donation:

- o Single Will: £200
- o Joint Will (Mirror Will): £300
- o Donations must be paid in advance to Bright Solicitors before any work commences.

### 3. Offer Conditions:

- o This offer cannot be used in conjunction with any other offer provided by Bright Solicitors.
- o The offer is only available for Standard/Simple Wills. Should your requirements fall outside this scope, Bright Solicitors will inform you at the earliest opportunity, and this offer will no longer apply. We may continue to provide a discount on our fees to the amount of your donation (or similar). However, this is at the discretion of the firm, and the offer may not apply.
- o The advertised offer for "Joint Wills", is for a Mirror Will - defined as a standard Will for a couple, either married or not, which simply mirror each other.
- o This offer is limited to first 20 applicants, on the basis of first-come, first-serve. This offer does not apply if all 20 slots are already filled.
- o This offer can be withdrawn or amended at any time, at the discretion of the firm.

### 4. Additional Costs:

Clients will be required to pay for:

- o ID fees: £25 + VAT per person
- o Any disbursements, if applicable.

### 5. Campaign Deadline:

- o Registration must be completed by 31st October.
- o All necessary forms must be returned by 2nd November.

### 6. Donation Handling:

Bright Solicitors will collect the donation from the client and forward the total amount to ACT at the end of the campaign.

### 7. Sharing Your Information:
